

How to use Talk it Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your family / friends turn what God is saying to you into action steps.

Pastor Tim's Main Idea:

Jesus is teaching us that as we give other literal bread, we have opportunity to give them spiritual bread.

Key Questions:

- What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- Why did Jesus feed the people instead of just sending them away? What does this mean for us?
- Jesus says that the bread represents his body. What does that mean to those he fed and to the disciples?
- How does feeding someone literal food better prepare them for the spiritual food? What does that mean to us as Christ-followers and the church?
- How should the Christian be ministering to the physical need of others by providing food?

Next Steps

- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
- Serve someone outside your church with the love of Jesus this week. Share your experience next week.
