

How to use Talk it Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your family / friends turn what God is saying to you into action steps.

Pastor Tim's Main Idea:

Jesus came to set us free and use us to set others free from bondage of slavery in many forms.

Key Questions:

- What's one idea from the message that really stood out to you? Why did this idea grab your attention?
- What does Jesus mean by "setting the captives free?"
- What are some of the demons people are bound by in our world today and how does Jesus set them free?
- Is there a relationship between self-destructive behaviors and mental illness? Why or why not?
- What do we know about the woman caught in the act of adultery? Who are others that are like her in our world today?

Next Steps

- What's one thing you will do this week as a result of something you learned from this message?
- How can God use the church to help set people free that are in bondage or slavery- both literally and figuratively?
